SUMMER STROLL RULES:

1. **No monetary transactions can be done on the street**, they all must take place inside of the store. **This includes credit cards and includes bill folders** for restaurants. **All patrons must pay inside** regardless of what they are paying for.
2. There **must be at least a fifteen foot clearance in the middle of the avenue**, to allow for emergency vehicle passage. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. To facilitate stroll closing and for sanitation clean-up , **ALL TABLES, CHAIRS DISPLAYS, BANDS OR ANYTHING ELSE PUT OUTSIDE MUST BE OFF THE STREET AND ON THE SIDEWALK AT 10:00pm- NO EXCEPTIONS- (Anyone who does not comply with this rule puts the Strolls in jeopardy and might not be allowed participation in future events)**
4. **FOR BARS AND RESTAURANTS-**
 - a. If serving alcohol
 - i. Those drinking alcoholic beverages must stay by restaurant/bar seating areas- **no one should be walking down the avenue with open containers.**
 - ii. The **extension of your premises** must be clearly defined and **MUST be cordoned off with rope/ tape or stanchions**
5. Remember to schedule all deliveries before 4pm. Street closures begin promptly at 4pm. Summer Stroll committee representatives will be on the avenue beginning at about 3:30
6. Please be respectful and mindful of all requests made by Summer Stroll representatives, marshals and NYPD representatives.
7. If you will have music of any type playing the music must only be for your customers and in the immediate area of your business. No music should be excessive loud or disruptive and should not be heard by an entire block. All outside music must be shut off by 10:00pm.
8. All permits are revocable by either SAPO or the SLA. Any violations of any rules can cause your permit to be revoked for future strolls/fairs.
